

PLAN COMMISSION HEARING NOTICE

Please take notice that the Plan Commission of the Village of Riverwoods (the Village) will hold a public hearing on January 11, 2018, at 7:30 p.m., in the Riverwoods Village Hall, 300 Portwine Road, Riverwoods, Illinois, to consider a text amendment substantially amending and restating the Riverwoods Woodland Protection Ordinance, codified as Chapter 6 of Title 9 of the Riverwoods Village Code. The proposed amendment modifies, deletes and adds various defined terms, incorporates provisions regulating the removal of trees by requiring a permit for trees over a certain height and size, restricts the removal of specified native trees with certain exceptions, establishes baseline woodland delineation parcel maps to establish the boundaries of protected woodland on each parcel in the Village, prohibits removal of protected woodland without a permit and removal of protected woodland over various prescribed limits, establishes penalties for violations and circumstances in which implementation of an ecological mitigation plan is allowed or required. The foregoing is a brief summary and the full text amendment should be consulted. In addition, the proposed text amendment may be varied subsequent to the hearing before the Plan Commission. The amendment as proposed will be available for inspection at the Riverwoods Village Hall and will be made available for viewing on the village website.

All persons desiring to be heard in support or opposition to the proposal shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard in person or to submit their statements in writing, or both. Further information may be obtained from Robert Durning, Riverwoods Director of Community Services (847-945-3990).
